The Charles Santore Library is a branch of the Free Library of Philadelphia that serves the residents, public schools, private schools and pre-schools of the South Philadelphia communities of Bella Vista, Queen Village, Hawthorne and Passyunk Square.

The Library opened in its current location on November 1, 1963. It was renovated in 1998 as part of the "Changing Lives" campaign, which refurbished branches and ensured Internet access. In 2010 and 2011 the Friends of the Charles Santore Library coordinated the renovation of the courtyard and achieved a space that is inviting, verdant, peaceful, and easy to maintain.
